Completed bid documents and supporting documentation are to be placed in a sealed envelope endorsed with " **RELEVANT PROJECT NAME AND CONTRACT NUMBER**" must be delivered to Batabile Construction Services Site Offices in Mount Fletcher Town (Next to the New Taxi Rank) not later than **12h00 on Friday, 07 September 2018** where tenders will be opened in public. Tender documents may be obtained from Batabile Construction Services Site Office in Mount Fletcher between 08:00 and 16:00 from Monday to Friday. The Tender Documents will be available from Monday, 20 August 2018.

Only those tenderers who satisfy the following eligibility criteria and who provide the required evidence in their tender submission are eligible to submit tenders and have their tenders evaluated:

1. Tender offers will only be accepted if:

- 1) the tenderer is registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD) for the South African government (see <https://secure.csd.gov.za/>) unless it is a foreign supplier with no local registered entity. Proof of registration with Central Supplier Database must be attached;
- 2) the tenderer provides written proof from SARS that the tenderer either has no Tax obligations or has made arrangements to meet outstanding Tax obligations, Tax Compliance status documents with PIN from SARS must be attached;
- 3) Proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor in the form of an appropriate original or certified completed affidavit or certified copy of a valid verification certificate from a verification agency accredited by SANAS and IRBA , recognized as an Accredited B-BBEE Verification Agencies or accounting officers as contemplated in the CCA or registered auditors;
- 4) the tenderer or any of its directors/shareholders is not listed on the Register of Tender Defaulters in
- 5) The financial offer is market related (See Regulation 6 (9) and section 7 (9) of the 8(9) of Preferential Procurement Regulation 2017;
- 6) the tenderer or any of its directors/shareholders is not listed on the Register of Tender Defaulters in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act of 2004 as a person prohibited from doing business with the public sector terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act of 2004 as a person prohibited from doing business with the public sector;
- 7) the tenderer has not:
 - i) abused the Employer's Supply Chain Management System; or
 - ii) failed to perform on any previous contract and has been given a written notice to this effect; and
- 8) the tenderer has completed the Compulsory Declaration and there are no conflicts of interest which may impact on the tenderer's ability to perform the contract in the best interests of the employer or potentially compromise the tender process.
- 9) the tenderer has completed the Compulsory declaration and there are no conflicts of interest which may impact on the tenderer ability to perform the contract in the best interest of the employer or potential compromise the tender process.
- 10) the statement of municipal account that is not older than three months or Lease Agreement OR Affidavit from SAPS stating that the bidder is not obliged to pay municipal rates OR a letter from a ward councillor is submitted with the tender document.
- 11) a company profile with contactable reference is required;
- 12) proof of Good Standing with Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases (COID) is required;
- 13) Proof of Valid CIDB grading registration is required.
- 14) the price(s) quoted are firm and are inclusive of VAT where applicable.
- 15) the Joint Venture has attached the following :
the agreement, original or certified copy of consolidated BBBEE certificate and the letter of signatory.

Bidders must take note of the following bid conditions

- Bidders must fully , sign tender documents and initial every page , incomplete tenders will result in a tender being non-responsive;
- Bidders must submit a letter intent for surety/ bank guarantee.
- Failure to submit and complete all supplementary information will result in the tender being null, void and non-responsive;

- The Employer does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid and reserves a right to accept the whole or part of the bid or to withdraw the bid;
- All copies to be submitted must be **CERTIFIED with CERTIFICATION DATE** within a period of three months from the date of tender closing, failure to do so will result to the tender being non-responsive;
- All alterations in prices must be signed for and failure to sign will result to the tender deemed non-responsive;
- Use of correction fluid is prohibited and shall lead to a bid being deemed non- responsive;
- The bidder must submit audited financial statements for the past three years for any offer amounting or exceeding 10 million;
- Failure to submit comprehensive JV agreement (where applicable), individual partners are to comply and submit all relevant documents. Failure to do so will result in tender offer deemed non-responsive;
- All MBD forms must be completely signed.

PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT (PPPFA) POINTS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS:

Tenders will be evaluated on 80 /20, wherein 20 points is for Price and 20 for BBBEE level of contribution
Received bids will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Stage 1 – Pre-qualification evaluation;
- Stage 2 – Price and Preferential Points

ALL BIDDERS SHOULD TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING BID CONDITIONS:

- A minimum of 70 points out of 100 for functionality is required in order to be asses for price;
- Specific functionality requirements will be detailed in each tender document. Bidders are requested to carefully read each bid document requirements;
- Bids which are late, incomplete, unsigned or submitted by facsimile or electronically, will not be accepted;
- Bids submitted are to hold good for a period of 90 days ;

Only locally produced or locally manufactured steel products and components for construction with a following minimum thresholds for local production and content will be considered.

- a) Reinforcement steel is 100%
- b) Cable is 90%
- c) Gabions is 100%
- d) Mesh reinforcement is 100%
- e) Galvanized steel cladding is 100%
- f) Frames is 100%
- g) Fasteners is 100%
- h) Columns is 100%
