

SPECIFICATION FOR LED STREETLIGHTS

Conditions

1. Supplier must be able to supply and deliver the required materials complete *as per specification* in Maclear town Elundini municipality offices.
2. The Supplier will be responsible for ordering, expediting and off-loading of the complete materials and shall include the cost thereof in his tender prices.
3. The supplier will have documentation on delivery to municipal stores to prove the origin of all the materials.
4. It will be the responsibility of the supplier to ensure upon arrival of complete materials that no visible damage has occurred and those quantities are correct. In the case of damaged material, acceptance shall be refused.
5. Only new and unused material of superior quality may be supplied. All materials shall, where applicable, comply with the applicable Standard and specification as indicated. It should be noted that all materials supplied under this contract as being IEC, BS or SABS approved shall be marked accordingly unless no such mark is applicable for a specific item.
6. Only materials that 100% comply with the specification shall be accepted. If any of the items does not meet required specification, permission to supply that item must be obtained from the Elundini Municipality representative.

Specification for LED Streetlight for use on B Category Roads

Body	The luminaire must consist of a 3 compartment design concept, an optical compartment with LED engine, gear compartment and a spigot compartment. Both optical and gear compartments must be rated IP66 to ensure long life.
Installation	Ease of installation of the luminaire must be achieved by means of a hinging action onto the spigot base casting. It must be secured by stainless steel latches and an access screw. Additionally an incorporated levelling device should be provided on the base casting.
Engine	The LED engine, consisting of the LED light source and the power supply must be easily replaced or upgraded.
Isolation	The power supply must be automatically disengaged when opening the luminaire
Surge Protection	For added protection the luminaire must be supplied with an integral 10kV/kA surge protection device which is external to the power supply.
Heat Protection	Electronic temperature monitoring preventing overheating of LEDs and power supply integrated into the power supply.
Switching	The top casting must be designed to be able to incorporate a NEMA type daylight switch device on request.
Variety	The luminaire must be able to accommodate several different lens options to allow flexibility of multiple light distributions to ensure that the specific requirements of each application are met.
Housing	The luminaire housing shall be manufactured of marine grade high pressure die cast aluminum (EN 1706 AC-44300) and must be available in an unpainted option as well as painted in a colour choice.
Load and Brightness	The luminaire must be available in 53w (lumen output no lower than 5300 lumen) or similar wattages and lumen outputs.

Spares	The luminaire materials and parts must be, where possible, manufactured, procured and assembled in South Africa.


